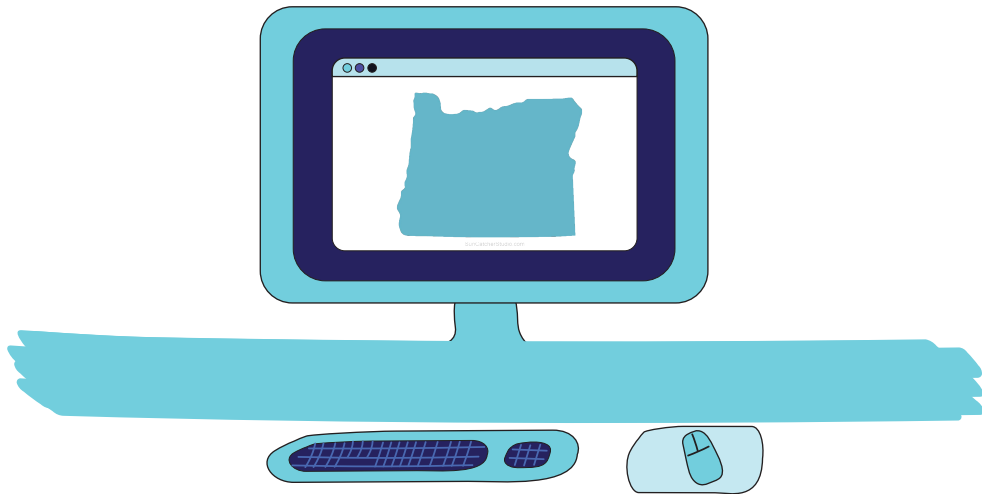


What to Do with Used Sharps in Oregon*

Sharps refer to: needles, syringes, lancets, auto injectors, including epinephrine and insulin pens, infusion sets, and connection needles/sets

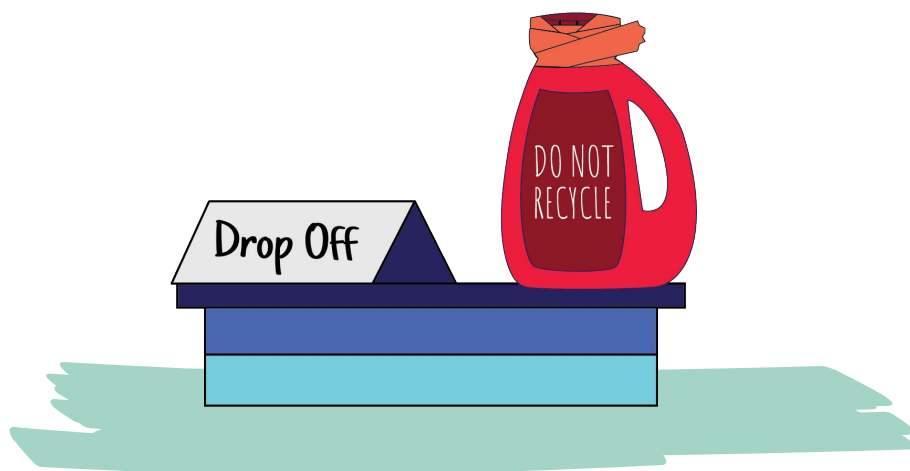


Put used sharps in a strong, plastic container that is **red**.

When the container is 3/4 full, put the lid on, seal it with duct tape and label **DO NOT RECYCLE**. Do not throw in the trash.

Containers of used sharps cannot be placed in the household trash in Oregon.

**These regulations are specific to the state of Oregon.
How you dispose of used sharps may be different, depending on where you live.
